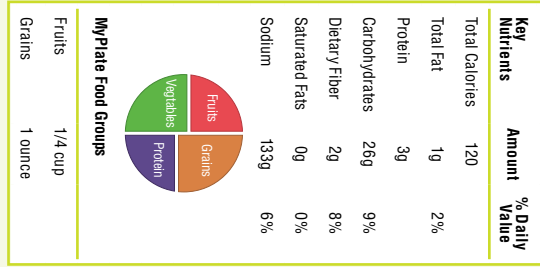
RECIPE
Apple Oatmeal Muffins

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup milk, non-fat
- 1/3 cup applesauce
- 1/2 cup flour, all-purpose
- 1/2 cup quick-cooking oats (uncooked)
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1/2 tablespoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 apple (tart, cored & chopped)

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 400°F.
- Place 6 cupcake holders in baking tin.
- In a mixing bowl, add milk and applesauce. Stir until blended.
- Stir in flour, oats, sugar, baking powder, and cinnamon. Mix until moistened (do not over mix).
- Gently stir in the chopped apples.
- Spoon into cupcake holders.



Apple taste testing is one way to learn the differences in apples including taste, texture and scent. Drive Yourself from market to market and taste the different varieties and take the "Apple Taste Test".

THE APPLE TASTE TEST

Three or more varieties are needed for comparison.

- Note flesh color:** White? Creamy? Yellow? Is the peel thin? Thick? Smooth? Leathery?
- Smell each apple:** Does it have a characteristic aroma? Which has the strongest aroma?
- Taste a slice of each variety.** Is it sweet? Tart? Sour?
- What about the texture?** Is it tender? Crisp? Juicy? Hard? Is the peel tender or tough?
- Which variety has the most flavor?** Which variety do you prefer to eat fresh? Out of hand?

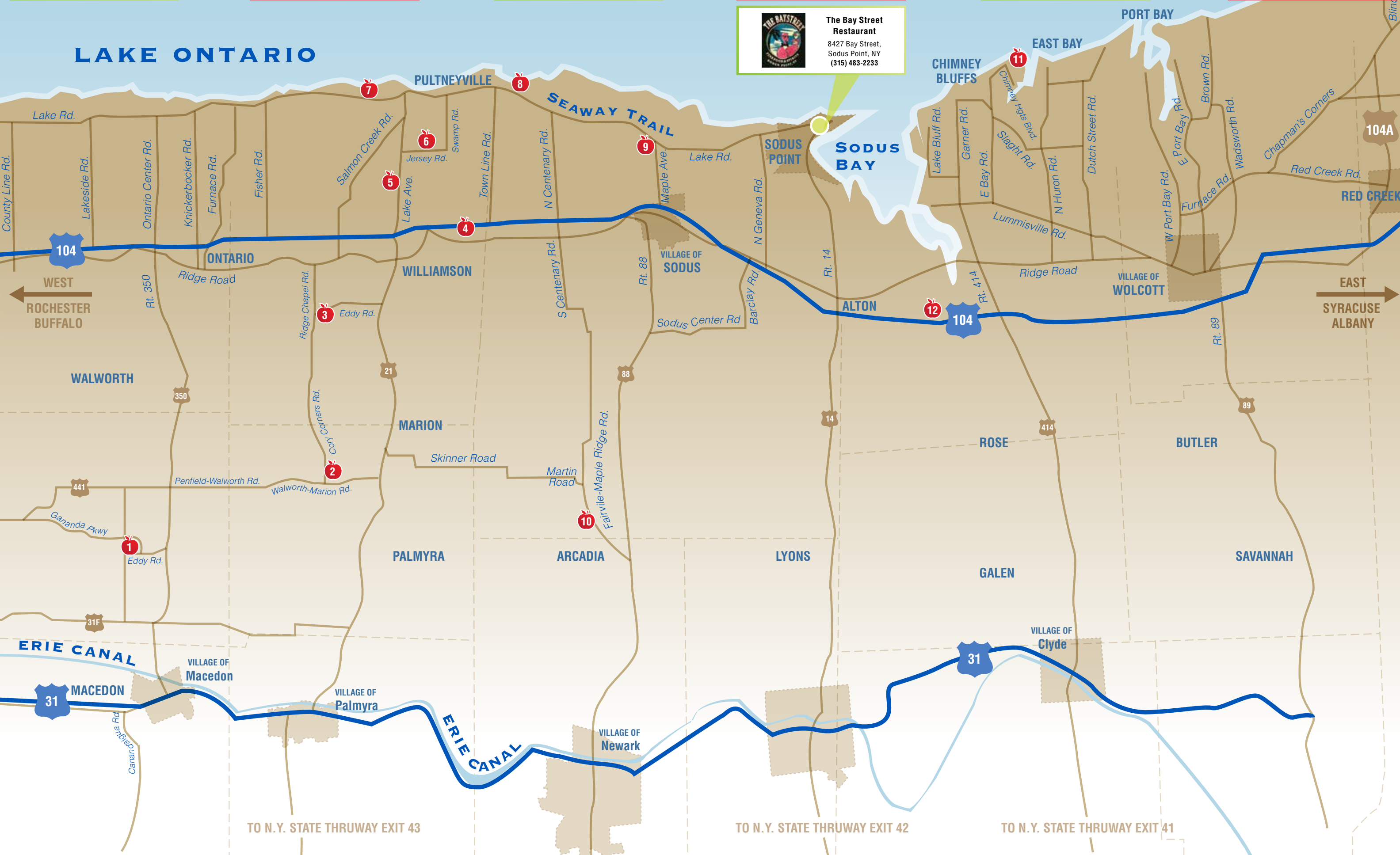
